Toddler Program (Ages 6 weeks - 12 Months)

Our Infant program offers a variety of opportunities to explore their world through play. Gross motor skills and social skills are developed through both structured and unstructured activities. Their days are filled with music, art, dance, story times and more.

Toddler Program (Ages 1-2)

Our toddlers are offered a variety of activities focused on sensory development, early literacy, social growth, motor development and self-help skills.

Preschool (Ages 3-5)

DISCIPLINE POLICY

As young children discover their own personalities and independence, they may encounter difficulties with other children. In the event that the teachers must intervene, we have outlined our most common techniques.

Environmental Manipulation: By setting up equipment and staff positioning themselves at key points throughout the room we can interact and encourage appropriate behavior when needed.

Redirection: Teachers attempt to redirect or divert children's attention to another toy, area, or activity in an attempt to avoid disruptive behavior.

Language Encouragement: Often times conflict arises and heightens due to young children's limited vocabulary. Teachers may step in and provide words to help solve conflict and give children a few minutes to compose themselves.

ABOUT OUR

The staff at the Boys & Girls Club Preschools are hand selected with your child's best interest in mind. We have the appropriate number of staff members to meet or exceed the Florida State licensing requirements at all times.

All of the staff have completed and passed Level 2 background checks, which includes local, state and national searches. Staff hold the minimum of the Child Care Development Associate Credentials to teach Early Childhood in the state of Florida. All staff are trained in CPR and First Aid for young children.
